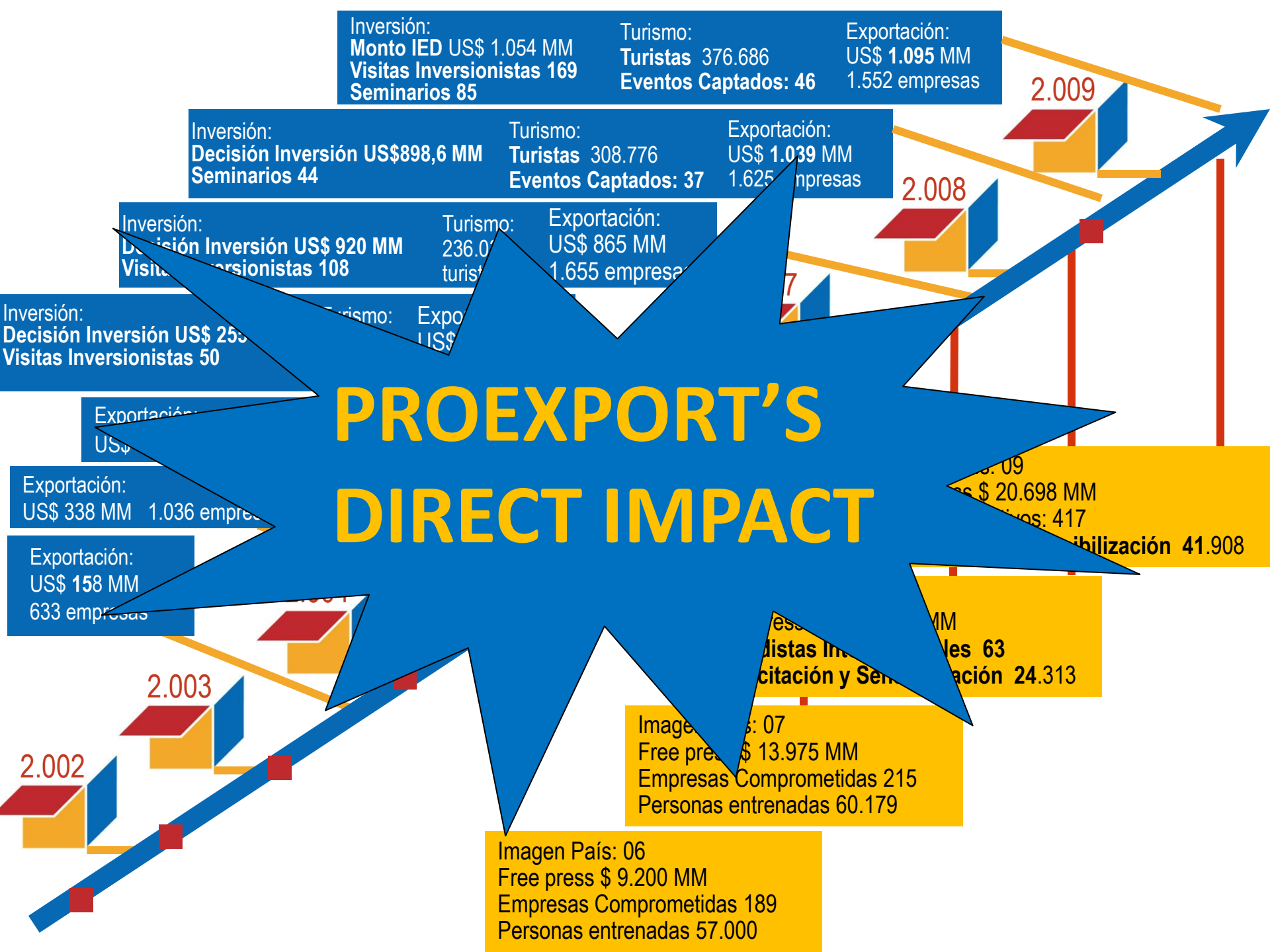

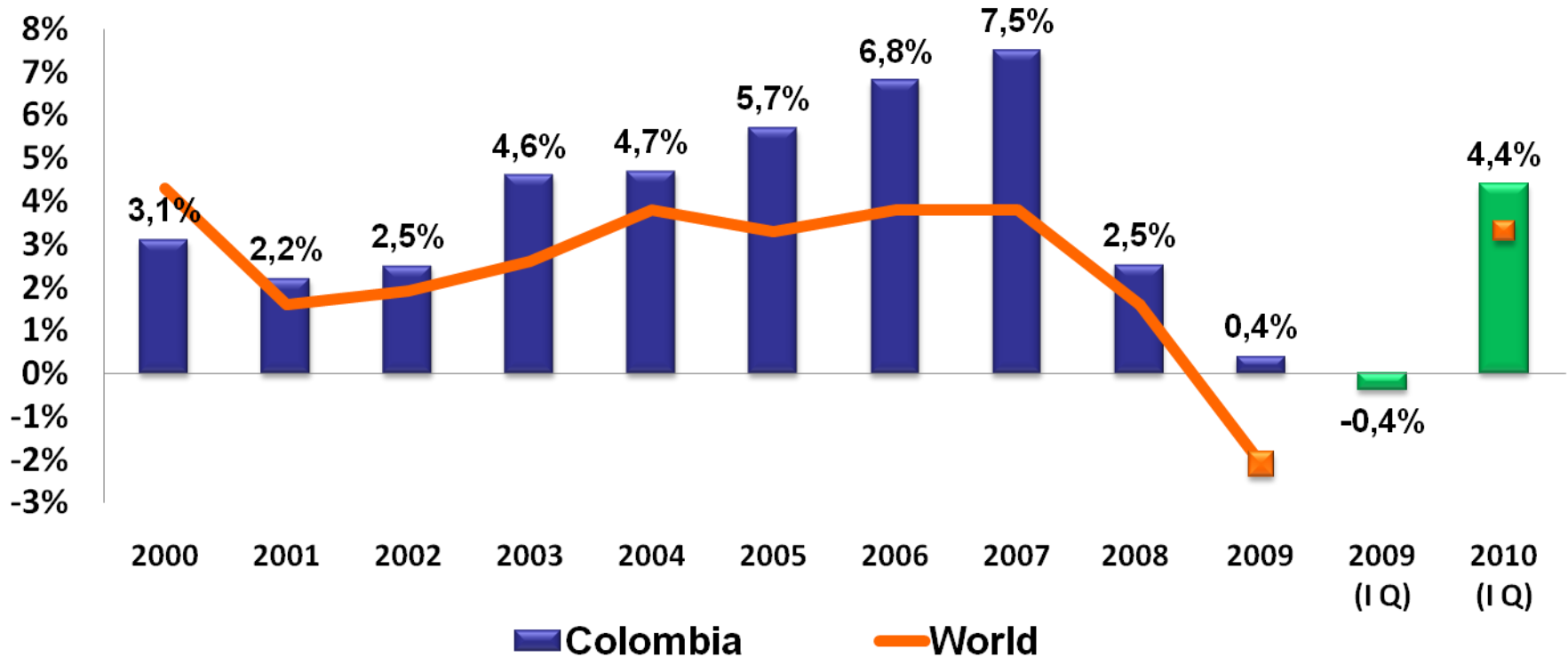

2000 – 2010



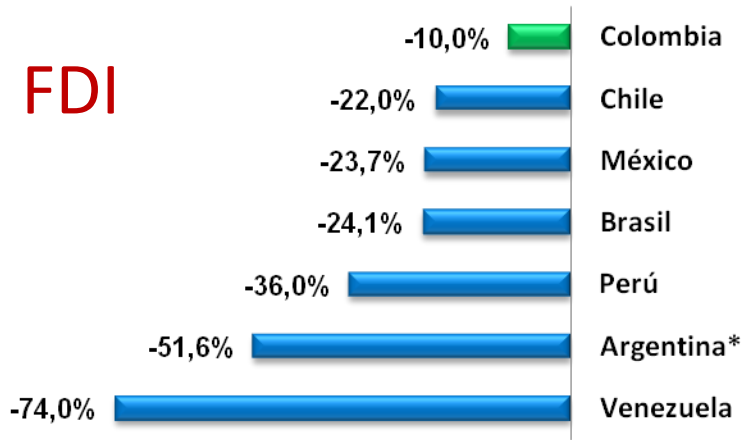

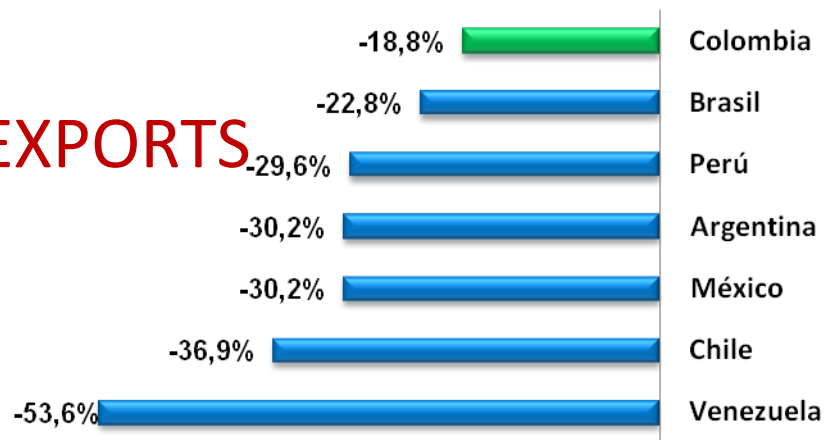

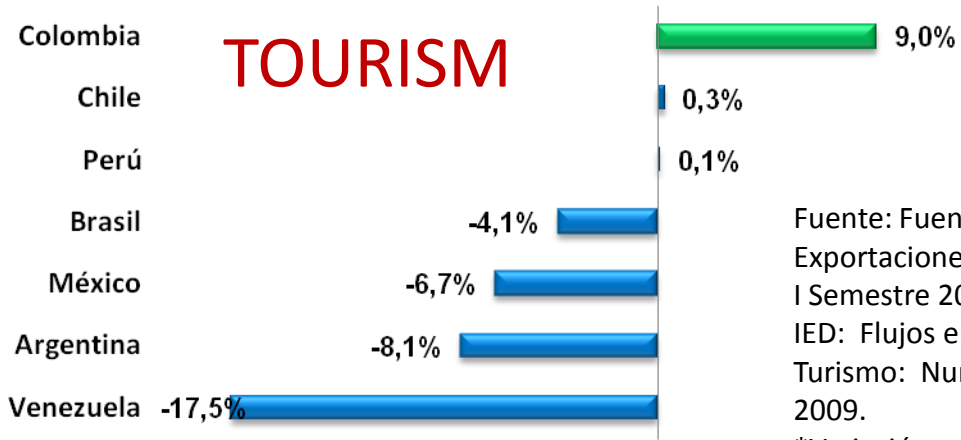

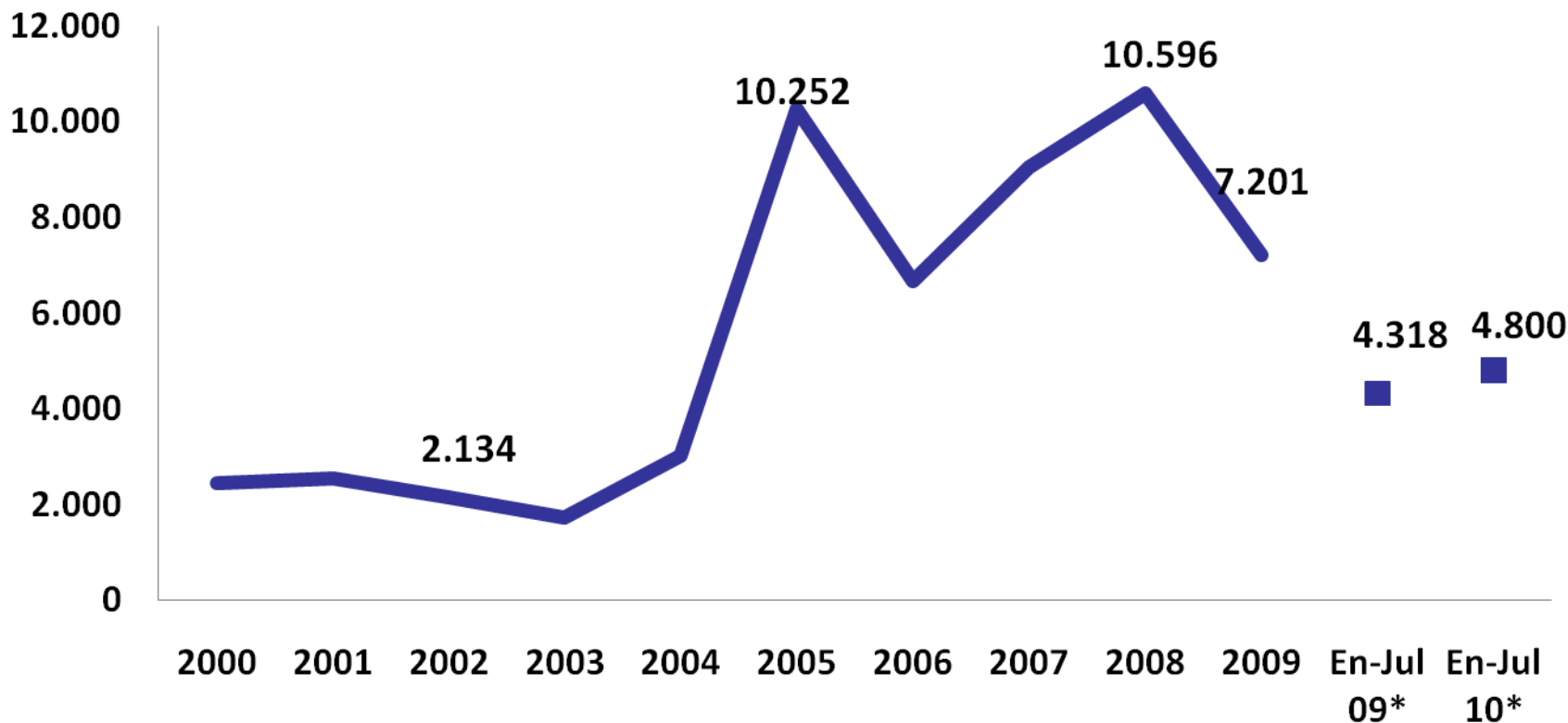

Variation 2008–2009: -32%

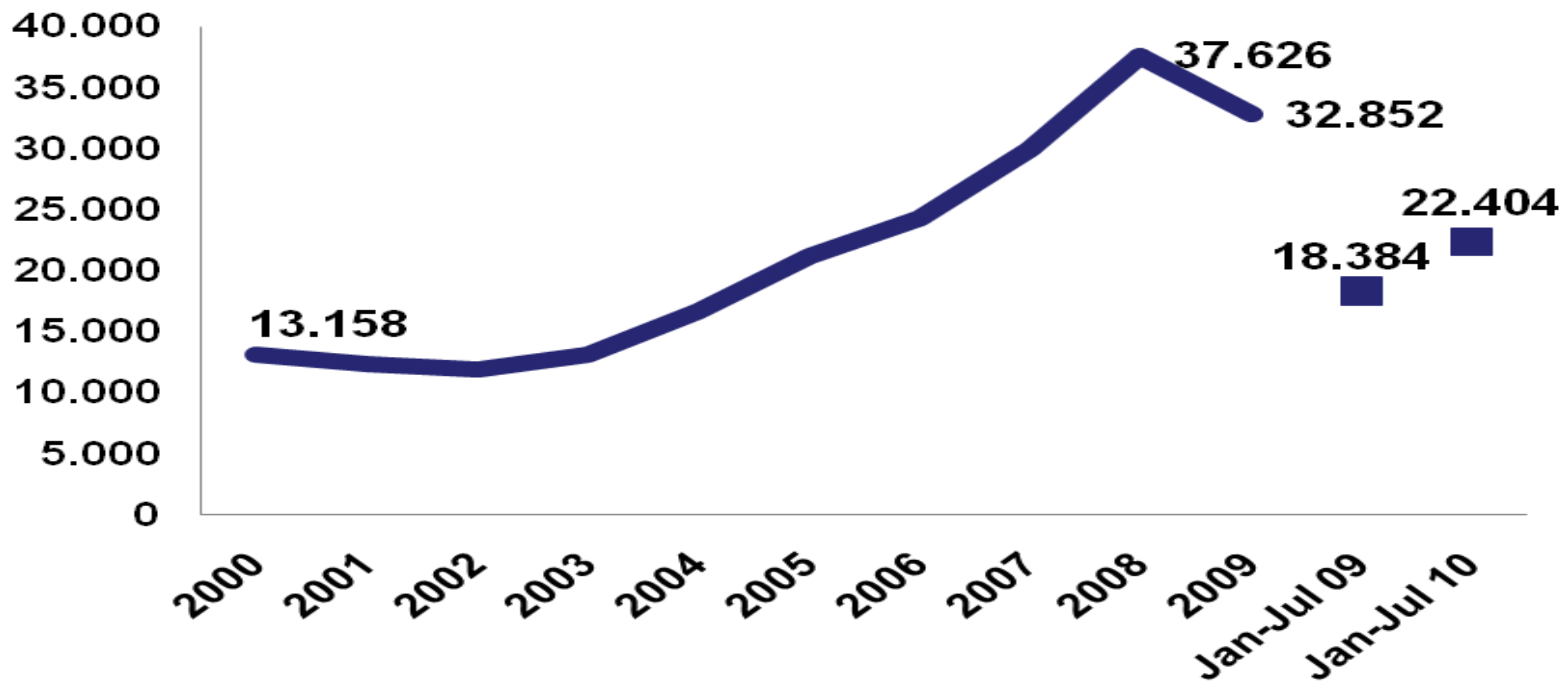

US\$ Million



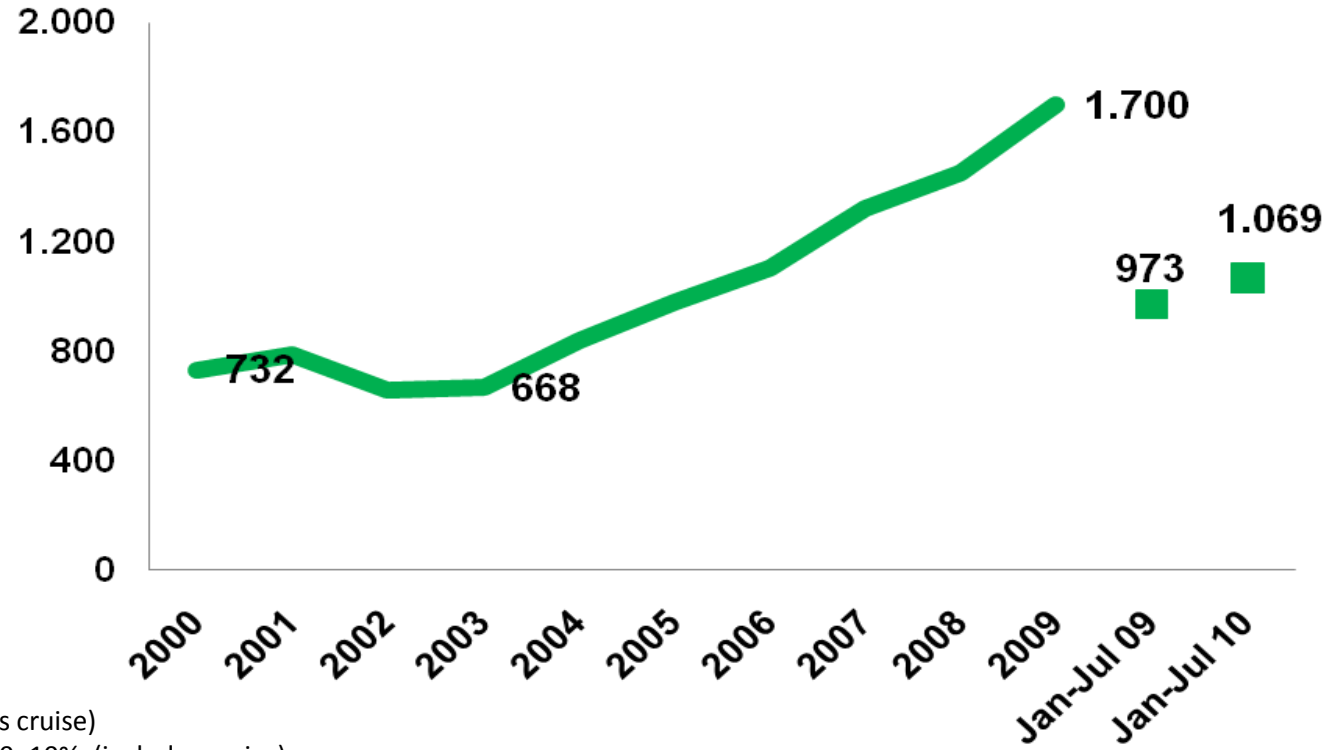


