

DATA SERVICES

TRAINING & MENTORSHIP

All our freelancers have been trained as professional online freelancers by Samasource and Celestine Ukpere Consulting as part of the Refugee Employment and Skills Initiative (RESI), a project from the International Trade Centre (ITC) and the Norwegian Refugee Council (NRC).

They are further supported with mentorship on life skills and entrepreneurship by technical experts, with the aim of constantly improving their technical skills with a support network.

SUCCESS STORIES

DATA COLLECTION

The Agency has conducted data collection for an NRC project on mapping businesses within the Dadaab refugee camps. The Agency was able to interview businesses across the 3 camps in Dadaab and upload the information gathered using the KoBoCollect application. Within 5 days, the Agency successfully collected data from over 500 businesses.

02.

SOFTWARE TESTING

Our freelancers have been involved in various end-user software tests. For instance, we recently participated in a video call software testing exercise where we tested the software's ability to onboard people based in various locations, testing the clarity and audibility of the voices while in the video, the quality of the images while using the camera and finally the break-out rooms and the ease of navigating from one room to another.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEOGRAPHY

The Agency was hired by ITC to take professional photos to be used in marketing materials for the organization's projects working in contexts of displacement.

SOCIAL MEDIA MARKETING

In partnership with the Kenya Private Sector Alliance (Kepsa), the Agency conducted an intensive social media marketing campaign for Elimu TV (an online portal offering online classes for primary and secondary schools in Kenya) at the height of the Covid-19 pandemic and realized impressive outcomes.

DATA ENTRY FOR AN INSURANCE CERTIFICATE COMPANY

The Agency worked with an insurance company based in the United States who needed quick and high quality data processing. The freelancers exported vital information from insurance certificates into an online platform.

TRANSLATION OF AN ENTREPRENEURSHIP E-COURSE

The Agency was hired by the ITC to translate an online course from English to Somali. The objective was to allow the Somali-speaking community to benefit from the content of the course. The course consisted of a general description, five modules of content, and an assessment to qualify for certification.

The eCourse is hosted by the SME Trade Academy of ITC.

TRANSLATION SERVICES

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

01.

WHAT IS ONLINE FREELANCING?

Online freelancing is an outsourcing of work tasks to experts that are hired and paid via online platforms. Online freelancers are often associated with gig work - work that is temporary and project-based. A company that needs to get specific work done, but does not need to hire a direct employee full time can hire a freelancer online to do a concrete task on a permanent or semi-permanent basis, as needed. Online freelancers are often hired on online work platforms, such as Upwork, which connect clients to freelancers from across the world.

02.

EXAMPLE: HOW ONLINE FREELANCING WORKS

Abdi has a successful business with sales increasing every quarter. Abdi and his staff do not have the time to enter their sales figures into their database, so Abdi hires Simon, an online freelancer who is an expert on data entry. Simon works for Abdi for a few days per month and is paid a monthly fixed price, negotiated through the online work platform. Later, Abdi decides to shift to a new database and hires Simon to transfer the data from the old database into the new database as a one-time project.

Abdi considers expanding to a new territory and wants to assess the market there. He is interested to know which types of businesses that are already present in this area, so he hires Hawo who is an online freelancer in web research. Hawo works to create a list of relevant businesses and is paid for the total number of hours of work after she has sent the final list to Abdi.

The market assessment turns out positive, and Abdi expands to this new territory where the community speaks a different language. Therefore, he needs to translate all of his marketing materials. He hires Emily, who is a translation freelancer, and pays her for each milestone. First, she translates Abdi's business card. Abdi likes to work with her, so he hires her to translate the business marketing brochure. Happy with Emily's work, Abdi hires her to translate the business website.



HOW DOES THE HIRING PROCESS WORK?

You can either hire the agency via Upwork or directly. When hiring our agency directly for a project, the process is usually broken into the following steps:

Step 1: Write to us at dadaabcollective@gmail.com specifying the nature of the work. Is it translation, transcription, data entry or any of the above? Tell us the amount of the work to be done, your deadlines and your tentative budget.

Step 2: Our agency will contact you to clarify details and will send you a tentative quote to be confirmed by you.

Step 3: We will engage our most appropriate freelancers to deliver the job within the timeframe established.

Step 4: Our agency carries out quality assurance on the deliverables and ensures that the work meets the expected standards.

Step 5: The delivery of the job is done within the agreed timeframe. As a client, you will revise the work done and ensure that you are satisfied with the result.

Step 6: Our agency will send you a final invoice for the services delivered and payment can be transferred.



WHAT PAYMENT METHODS DO WE ACCEPT?

We accept the following payment methods:

- 1. Banking transfer to Kenyan bank account
- 2. Transfer to our PayPal account
- 3. Credit card via Upwork (for a Upwork fee of 3%)
