President, Bangladesh Association of Software and Information Service (BASIS)



Mr. Mashroor was earlier this year elected president of the Bangladesh Association of Software & Information Services (BASIS), the national trade agency representing software and IT services industry of Bangladesh. As president he represents the country's ICT industry in several high-level government bodies, including the National Digital Task Force, the Export Promotion Bureau (EEPB) and the Bangladesh Computer Council (BCC).

He has more than a decade's experience in the IT industry and is the founder and CEO of Bdjobs.com, an online employment exchange, which was launched in 2000 and is among the top five job sites in South Asia. In 2008, Mr. Mashroor was named "Best Innovative Entrepreneur" by the Dhaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

Before his current role as BASIS President, he served as the organization's Senior Vice-President. He also served on Executive Committee of BASIS as EC in 2004-2008, and was in charge of BASIS SoftExpo 2007 and BASIS SoftExpo 2011.

Mr. Mashroor has also been involved in a number of social-development activities in voluntary capacity. He is a trustee and Governing Body Member of D.Net, a non-profit development organization promoting ICT literacy and the use of ICT for social development.

He is a graduate of the University of Dhaka.
